Public Hearing #2 regarding abandonment of a portion of Castle Drive opened by Supervisor Eaton at 7:30 pm. He advised that this is a request for the COR Development company to take over to be a part of the University Commons Project. COR will take care of the road way that is left and it will be cut off from regular traffic, in fact it will be a dead end. The land surrounding is entirely owned by St. Bonaventure University. Supervisor Eaton accepted comments from the floor regarding this issue. None were made; therefore, this public hearing was closed at 7:33pm.

#2-MOTION TO CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING ON CASTLE DRIVE ABANDONMENT

Motion by Potter to close the public hearing on the abandonment of a portion of Castle Drive. 2nd by Higgins. Higgins-aye, Potter-aye, Hitchcock-aye, Wolf-aye, Eaton-aye. CARRIED.

Public Hearing #3 regarding the Comprehensive Town Wide Water District was opened by Supervisor Eaton at 7:35 pm. Supervisor Eaton gave a summary of this action and advised that comments or questions will be accepted on the document that each resident received only. This public hearing addresses the administration of the water district. Supervisor Eaton accepted comments from the floor. A number of people questioned the fact that if the water lines go through their property and they don't want public water, will they have to pay? This question is not what this public hearing is for. Supervisor Eaton advised the public that as water districts are formed, there will be a public hearing for that

specific district. Since there were no other questions on the document, the public hearing was closed at 7:55pm.
