

VILLAGE OF ALLEGANY
THE FOLLOWING ARE RULES FOR REFUSE PICKUP:

- Garbage must be wrapped and in metal or heavy plastic garbage containers of a quantity sufficient to hold contents. All disposable containers must be closed and/or tied shut.
- Containers and contents must not exceed fifty (50) pounds.
- Containers must be drums, metal or plastic cans, or heavy grade of plastic bags.
- Containers must be kept covered and in sanitary condition prior to collection.
- All trash must be free from ice and water.
- Any water-proof containers with handles may be used to hold items for curb collection. Approved containers are bushel baskets, 5 gallon pails or plastic bins.

- Casella Waste (our waste pick-up provider) now offers “ZERO-SORT RECYCLING” which allows you to direct all recyclables into a single bin. Casella sorts the recycling materials at their state of the art processing facility enabling them to produce clean commodities for manufacturing new products.
- Items to be included in the recycling are:
 - Cardboard-Cereal boxes, pizza boxes, paper towel cores, etc.
 - Glass-any color bottles and containers
 - Metal-aluminum, tin, steel containers (soup cans, kitchen cans, aluminum pie plates/trays, foil, etc.)
 - Plastic-Containers #1-#7 (milk jugs, detergent, shampoo bottles, etc.)
 - Paper-newspapers, junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, soft cover books, telephone books, brown bags, magazines and inserts, etc.)

- All rules and regulations set forth in the Village of Allegany Local Law No.1, 1990 and Local Law No. 1, 1991 will be followed.
