

Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes
Joint Meeting –Town of Allegany with the Village of Allegany
Regarding Annexation of Property
2/21/2017 6:00 PM

A special meeting with the Town of Allegany and the Village of Allegany was called to order at 6:00pm with a salute to the flag led by Village Mayor Gregory Pearl.

Attorney Joseph Miller representing the Village of Allegany opened the meeting with the introduction of the petition for the annexation of two properties currently residing in the Town of Allegany in which the Village of Allegany will extend water and sewer to said properties. Attorney Joseph Miller opened the floor to the public for any questions or concerns:

Resident Thomas Stetz had the following questions:

“Are you the Village attorney?”

Answer by Attorney J. Miller: No I am not the Village attorney.

“Is the property contiguous?”

Answer by Attorney J. Miller: The properties are contiguous.

“What is the purpose of the annexation?”

Answer by Attorney J. Miller: The purpose of the annexation is that the property would be less desirable if it doesn't have access to the Village water and sewer.

Town Attorney Wendy Tuttle stated that it would be more expeditious to get it done this way.

“Does the annexation include the other lots in front of the Tiller property?”

Answer by Attorney J. Miller: No it does not. He then displayed a map of the properties for the public to view.

“Will other properties along 7th Street be able to hook up to the water/sewer.”

Answer by Attorney J. Miller: No not at this time, but could be discussed at a later date. This meeting is just for the annexation of property.

“I thought the town created a water and sewer district?”

Answer by Town Supervisor J. Hare: Only a water district was created. The sewer district has not been created as of yet.

Resident Michael Silluzio asked: “What are the next steps?”

Attorney J. Miller stated that each board is required to make a resolution to proceed with the annexation per General Municipal Law Article 17. They would address this at their next board meeting to approve or deny the petition for annexation.

Town Attorney W. Tuttle asked if there were anymore comments. There were no more comments.
