 - Reasons: Same as what is currently in the neighborhood
- 2. Whether benefit sought by applicant can be achieved by a feasible alternative to the variance: Board vote **NO**
 - Reasons: No additional parcels to purchase or anywhere else to go
- 3. Whether the requested variance is substantial: Board vote \boldsymbol{YES}

Reasons: All businesses in that area do not meet the criteria either

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4. Would the variance have an adverse impact on the physical or environmental conditions in the neighborhood: Board vote **NO**

Reasons: New layout addresses concerns

5. Whether the alleged difficulty was self-created: Board vote **NO**Reasons: <u>Purchased 2 lots to ease problem caused by C1 changed to C2</u>

The ZBA, after taking into consideration the above five factors, finds that: The Benefit to the Applicant **DOES** outweigh the Detriment to the Community.
