# Routine:

# Water:

- Installed 8" tie in to Field of Dreams loop.
- Installed Meter dots on Cottages 1 2 and 3.
- Assisted plumber with pressure test for new main at Field of Dreams
- Read quarterly water meters and completed re-reads that were needed
- Repaired broken water box covers on 4<sup>th</sup> and Chestnut
- Painted fire hydrants and painted hydrant numbers on each hydrant. The tags that were originally attached for identification were starting to fail.
- Repaired a blown fuse at Wellhouse #2 that caused the pump to not run. CTM electric fixed the issue.

# Sewer:

- Had a control issue at Lift Station 1, one of the pumps did not shut off like it should have.
   Ordered and replaced HOA (hand/off/auto) switches on each pump as they are original switches
- Upgraded Multismart controller at Lift Station #1, however the unit was not working correctly and had to be sent back. The old controller was re installed and once the company gets the new multismart fixed Xylem will come and install it.

# Streets:

- Installed new DI (catch basin) that was collapsing at William & Clarence intersection
- Repaired collapsing DI on N. 1<sup>st</sup> Street
- Continued working on Sewer road along Railroad tracks for Sewer manhole access.

# Parks:

- Removed Kayak pad and bouys from river
- Winterized park bathrooms and shut off water to drinking fountain
